

PROP 13

2020 State School Bond Californians for Safe Schools and Healthy Learning

Assembly Bill 48 (O'Donnell), the *Public Preschool, K-12 & College Health & Safety Bond Act of 2020*, places Proposition 13 - a \$15 billion state school facilities bond - on the ballot for the March 3, 2020 Statewide Primary Election. Community Colleges will receive \$2.0 billion from this bond if passed by the voters.



Community Colleges have more than \$40 billion in facility needs over the next ten years. Proposition 13 will help address those needs.

The \$2.0 billion designated for Community Colleges in Proposition 13 will be allocated through the State Budget process, providing funds for health and safety, modernization and new construction projects.

Timeline

- The campaign to *educate California voters on the need for a 2020 State School Bond* has hit the ground running for a sprint to February!
- However, there are less than 100 days to campaign before California voters receive their absentee ballots for the March 3, 2020 Statewide Primary Election. Absentee voters can vote when they receive their ballots, as early as February 3, 2020.
- There are three major holidays between October and February, when campaigning is difficult.
